



## Donate Medical Supplies to Support Turkey and Syria Disaster Response

On February 5, 2023, Southern Turkey and Northern Syria experienced a devastating 7.8 earthquake with a 6.2 aftershock. Civilian infrastructure and health infrastructures have been damaged across the affected regions. More than 3,000 deaths and 20,000 injuries have occurred in Turkey, with more than 1,500 deaths occurring in Syria. The call for the donation of emergency medical supplies has been activated.

**IDMC and MedGlobal are seeking the donation of the following medical supplies:**

- Saline (IV bags & irrigation bottles)
- Analgesics
- Antibiotics (oral & topical)
- Surgical Kits
- Anesthetic Medicines
- Gauzes
- Sutures & Staplers
- Albuterol
- Ice & Heating Packs
- Oxygen Disposable Supplies
- Ophthalmic Kit (tetracaine, ophthalmoscope, fluorescence strips, UV light)
- PPE (gloves, masks, disposable gowns)
- Insulin needles
- Steroids (prednisone, methylprednisolone)
- Orthopaedic Kits (External Fix, Interlocking plates)
- Blankets
- Mattresses
- Stop the Bleed Kits
- Tourniquet Kits
- Laboratory Kits (Blood Banks)
- Fuel
- Spare Parts for Vehicles
- Search & Rescue Equipment
- Tires for Vehicles
- Ambulance Equipment
- Uniform & Safety Boots
- Ultrasound
- Splints
- Chest Tubes
- First Line Cardiac Equipment & Meds

The collection of donations will be organized by IDMC's Logistics Team. MedGlobal has secured transport of any supplies collected within the United States.
